



Armenia Highlights

5 Days / 4 Nights

Starting \$ 440

DAY 01 : Arrival in Yerevan, meeting at the airport, transfer to the hotel.
Leisure time & Overnight at the hotel.

DAY 02 : Yerevan City Tour
Breakfast at hotel. Yerevan... rose-colored capital even during winter time.... most of its buildings are garnished with a pink shade of “tuf” stone which is quarried in Armenia.

Sightseeing tour in morning Yerevan with photo-stops at the statue of Sasuntsi David, in the market of dried fruits, nuts and sweets - GUM, at the city hall of Yerevan, on Mashtots avenue, on Baghramian avenue, at the Presidential residence, at the National Assembly, at the monument "Mother Armenia".

Visiting Cascade Opera Northern Ray-Republic Square. After the Cascade and the Opera, we walk along the North Avenue to Abovyan Street, from where we continue our walk to the Republic Square. Back to the hotel.

DAY 03 : Tsakhkadzor - Sevan

Breakfast at hotel. Trip to Tsakhkadzor – “Valley of Flowers”. You will spend three unforgettable days in the relaxing Wintery Wonderland in the town of Tsaghkadzor. Tsaghkadzor is surrounded by forests on the eastern slope of Mt. Tsaghkuniats. Located in one of the most beautiful areas of the country, the town is famous for its numerous resorts. Its once pristine hunting grounds for the rulers of Armenia are now important for its modern touristic areas, ski runs and winter rest with a number of rest houses, hotels, motels and camps. Visit to Sevan Lake, which has the alluring beauty of nature. Sevanavank monastery is also in this area that will surprise you with a stunning depiction of Jesus Christ made by the rarest cross-stones. Return to Yerevan.

DAY 04 : ECHMIADZIN- GARNI – GEGHARD

Breakfast at hotel. Trip to Echmiadzin – visiting Noah’s Hrbour. Then trip to Garni Temple – the only monument preserved in the pagan and Hellenistic period in Armenia, dedicated to the sun god Mihr. Built in the year of 76 BCE by King Trdat I and served as a summer residence of Armenian kings. The remains of the old fortress and the royal palace, as well as the baths built in the 3rd century, have been preserved at the temple. Here is a wonderful view of the river of Azat River, Garni gorge. Geghard Monastery is one of the greatest medieval architectural structures in Armenia. Geghard is completely hollowed out in a cave, it is also called a “cave monastery”. The name of the monastery complex Geghard (spear) comes from the Langin’n spear, which pierced the body of Jesus Christ on the cross. The monastery complex Geghard is included in UNESCO World Heritage List. Return to Yerevan.

DAY 05 : Breakfast at hotel. Transfer to the airport.
